February 14-19 Cruising Catamaran vacation

course: Complete your Cruising Catamaran certification (ASA 114) while enjoying a relaxing vacation in the British Virgin Islands. Our live-aboard yacht is a 40' 2023 Lagoon (photo above) with 4 double cabins, 4 heads and onboard WiFi. Board our boat in Road Town, Tortola, BVI. Yacht details:

We set sail each morning and anchor off a different island by early afternoon each day. Afternoons are for relaxing on the beach, shopping, snorkeling, swimming, and enjoying all the sights of this magnificent group of islands. We will use our motorized dinghy for sightseeing and dinner excursions. You will learn twin screw operation, diesel engine checks, crew overboard techniques, emergency procedures, reefing, anchoring, sail trim, cooking underway, live-aboard skills, driving to mooring ball, and learn to expertly dock a cruising cat.

Non-student friends and family members are welcome on this cruise, though ASA 104 is the prerequisite for ASA 114 Cruising Catamaran certification. All onboard are welcome to take the helm and learn all crewing skills.

Optional additional certification: ASA 116 Dinghy/Outboard - includes textbook & certification.

ITINERARY: Board February 13 starting at 5pm at BVI Yacht Charters, Road Town, Tortola. Set sail for Marina Cay the next morning after orientation. We will spend one night at Marina Cay and 2 nights at Virgin Gorda, practice docking, explore The Baths, then sail to Salt, Cooper, Peter, Norman or other islands and National Park anchorages. Disembark February 19 by 12PM.

Included: All boat costs. Includes mooring balls, fuel, taxes, onboard Wifi, textbook; Cruising Catamarans Made Easy, ASA certification, shared double berth, bed linens, towels, breakfasts and lunches onboard, coffee, and bottled water. Packing list and textbook will be sent upon registration. (ASA 104 is prerequisite for those completing the 114 course)

Not included: Transportation to charter base, dinners ashore, taxi & entry to The Baths (optional), personal beverages & snacks. BVI uses American dollar currency. Contact Capt. Joan for flight and hotel suggestions.

GETTING THERE: Fly into BVI; airport code-EIS and take 45 minute taxi to BVI Yacht Charters, Ritter Marina, Wickham's Cay, Road Town, Tortola - or - Fly into St Thomas: airport code-STT and take 5-minute taxi to Charlotte Amalie ferry dock. Take 45-minute ferry ride to Road Town, Tortola then 5-minute taxi to BVI Yacht Charters. St. Thomas ferries stop running in early afternoon, so check ferry schedules. Please purchase ferry tickets in advance - see <https://www.bvitourism.com/ferry-schedules>
